



PROCEDURE TO BE PROMOTED FROM JUNIOR TO SENIOR INSPECTOR

1. The candidate should have done 30 inspections as a junior inspector.
2. The candidate must be nominated (proposed and seconded) by two senior inspectors.
3. The candidate should have worked with the inspectors mentioned above.
4. The candidate must be evaluated by two other senior inspectors at two separate inspections.
5. The candidate must act as a senior inspector during the inspections and then be evaluated by the senior inspectors.
6. It should preferably not be done at sale screenings.
7. Each senior inspector must complete a separate evaluation report and send it to the office.
8. If the candidate is one of the two inspectors who is doing an inspection, the candidate may claim as normal.
9. If the candidate went along with two other inspectors to do an inspection, for evaluation purposes, the candidate may not claim for the inspection. Only two inspectors can claim per inspection.
